Just choose the price level at which Load Guard will automatically moderate your central A/C usage during high-priced hours. When this price level is reached, Load Guard automatically switches your central A/C into a conservation mode for the following two-hour period. Your air conditioner's fan remains on, circulating the already cooled air throughout your home.

TheWattSpot.com monitors electricity prices continuously. So, if a two-hour conservation period is completed, and the current price remains above your selected level, then another conservation period will automatically begin.

Choose the Load Guard price activation level that's right for you.

Cooler for the Planet. Choose the **Green Level**, which activates the two-hour central A/C conservation period whenever the price reaches 10 cents. This is a good choice to take action towards a greener environment for us all. Since you'll use less electricity during times of high demand, fewer greenhouse gases will be emitted by our power suppliers trying to meet that demand.

Cooler for your Home. Choosing the **Blue Level** delays activation of the two-hour central A/C conservation period, until the price reaches 14 cents. This is a good choice if you prefer a cooler indoor temperature, while protecting against extreme electricity prices.

Whichever price level you choose, with Load Guard, it's all completely automated. Anytime during the day, you can change your price activation level for the following day. You just 'Set-It-and-Forget-It.'

Joining Load Guard is easy – and it's free, too.

To be eligible for Load Guard, you must be an RRTP Participant and enrolled in the ComEd Nature First program. There is no cost to enroll in either program, but you must remain on the ComEd RRTP program for a minimum of 12 months.
