Summary of this summer's Summer Readiness Workshops

This June, ComEd Residential Real-Time Pricing program participants and other area residents gathered to learn about managing household energy costs during the summer. Nearly 100 people attended the workshops, which took place in Chicago, Elgin, Aurora, Evanston, Park Forest, and Chicago Ridge.

The workshops began with an overview of the RRTP program and a discussion of the summer real-time price patterns. Then presenters outlined strategies for shifting electricity usage to off-peak times, for example cooking large meals on the weekend so leftovers can be quickly reheated during the week.

Topics also included opportunities to become more energy-efficient in general, such as unplugging appliances and cell phone chargers that are not in use. Each session ended with questions from the audience and a chance for ComEd RRTP participants to talk with presenters and each other about their experiences with the RRTP program.
